Explanation Leaflet

What is covered :-

Cover is anywhere within the EEC. In fact it is a worldwide policy but there are restrictions in some areas especially the United States And Canada so it is advisable to check before using it outside the EEC

Limit of cover is Ten Million Pounds

Covers all models up to 2.5 metres in length with a maximum i.c. engine size of 35cc and all electric powered models. Gas turbine powered boats are specifically **NOT** covered by this insurance.

Although cover is provided on all waters in the EEC if you are running on a private water you should ensure you have the owners permission to use it to avoid any problem in the event of a claim.

Does not cover boats being run on tidal waters or on the sea.

Insurance cover is provided on the premise that boats are run in accordance with the relevant Section Rules.

Cover for club safety/rescue boats is provided where the "crew" is fully trained in its use for duties carried out under relevant health and safety issues. A signed/dated record to be kept to show training received. A risk assessment should be carried out at each location and reviewed regularly by competent official.

With regard to steam all boats must be in possession of valid boiler/ gas tank test certificates.

Persons qualified to test boilers/ gas tanks are covered whilst carrying out these tests.

Who is covered :-

Only fully paid up members of the MPBA and it's officers and directors except as in (b) below. A valid membership card is proof of insurance.

B) In the event of an affiliated club running an official MPBA event then the officers in charge of the event are covered regardless of whether they are members of the MPBA or not.

An official MPBA event is any event approved by the MPBA, some examples are, qualifying events for Local, Regional, National competitions. Non-competitive events. Events held under the banner of the MPBA.

c) Members are now covered against allegations of sexual abuse provided they have conformed to the MPBA Child Protection Policy

Damage to boats on the water is not covered as this is considered to be a hazard of the hobby.
